What is the Comprehensive Plan?

The Comprehensive Plan is James City County’s master plan for the future, addressing such topics as land use and development, population, economics, housing, parks and recreation, the environment, public facilities and services, transportation, and community character. The plan is reviewed every five years.

What is “Historic Past, Sustainable Future” and how can I get more information?

“Historic Past, Sustainable Future” is the theme for the 2008 Comprehensive Plan update process. Citizen participation is vital to this process to ensure that the Comprehensive Plan reflects the goals and values of the community. What is the timeline for the process?
