



WELCOME TO THE GREENSPRINGS INTERPRETIVE TRAIL

Each park has posted rules and regulations to assist patrons and staff in providing a safe, enjoyable and clean environment for all park users. Please refer to the James City County Parks & Recreation Public Facilities Rules and Regulations for other rules and regulations not listed below. - Animals, except service animals as defined under the Americans with Disabilities Act, are not permitted on athletic fields, sport courts, playgrounds, or any other designated facilities.
- Hitting golf balls, archery, kites or remote controlled aircraft are permitted in designated areas only.
- Single free-standing canopies, tents and other types of portable shade structures up to 16'x16' are permitted in designated areas of parks and must be anchored per manufacturer's recommendations with tie downs marked in a noticeable manner.
- Smoking, including the use of E-cigarettes, is not permitted within 25 feet of athletic fields, sport courts, playgrounds, bleachers, pools, rinks, or any other designated facilities.
- Use of fryers and towable smokers/grills require an approved Park Use Permit and are permitted in designated areas only. Charcoal is permitted in park-provided grills only and designated camping areas.
- Music or noise in violation of the County's Noise Ordinance (audible at 50 feet) is prohibited.
- Pets must be on a leash no longer than eight feet, and under the owner's complete and immediate control at all times. Owners are responsible for the removal of pet waste.
- Motorized vehicles (except ADA mobility devices) are not permitted on bikeways, pedestrian paths or trails and must be parked in designated spaces.
- Trail is open daily sunrise to sunset; however, parking at the trailhead available 8 a.m. to sunset.
- The following are prohibited: use of any type of metal-detecting device; and bikes, except on the section of trail that connects Jamestown Hundred and St. George's Hundred with the Powhatan Creek Trail.
