What are natural and cultural assets?

They include trees and forests, waterways, wetlands, agricultural soils and natural areas such as parks and trails, or areas of cultural significance to residents such as scenic or historic areas. The largest blocks of intact habitats support native species and can be connected by corridors to form a network.
